

Bourbon County Band Booster Meeting

January 19, 2009

President Tamara Johnson opened the meeting at 6:01 p.m. Sarah Auvenshine was absent from our meeting, so there were no secretary reports distributed. Barbara Rupard distributed the Treasurer's Reports. There were no changes or additions; the report was approved by common consent.

Old Business: No old business to discuss.

New Business: We are having a lawn mower (tractor) donated to raffle off. The Modern Woodmen will match up to \$2500. We discussed selling the tickets for \$10.00 each with each student selling 10 tickets. James Arnold moved to sell the tickets at \$10.00 each, Barbara Rupard 2nd and the motion carried.

Raffle: The raffle tickets must be printed. Frankie Reynolds stated she would talk to Ad Graphix about purchasing perforated tickets. Discussions ensued concerning the dates to hold the raffle. Vickie Handy moved to start the raffle February 1st, ending March 27th, with the drawing being March 30th. Kelly McIntosh 2nd, motion carried.

Blair Rule stated that we needed to turn our raffle information into the gaming commission and he would give to Albert.

Bingo: We have had very poor attendance recently. We would like to try to eliminate the groups that are working to sell pull-tabs as we are out \$200 each night we have a different group. Tamara wanted to make everyone aware of the situation.

Fundraisers: Bev Bales brought in a new fundraiser idea. We would sell certificates for \$9.95 for photos. If we sold fifty certificates, there would be a corporate match of up to \$500. This offer would expire February 23rd. The company would set up a mobile unit for the pictures. We would have to have volunteers to check people in. Mr. Hale stated that Olan Mills has the same offer going on at the present time. After some discussion, it was decided to put this fundraiser on hold.

BOA Nationals: Mr. Hale notified the band boosters that the deadline to sign up for BOA Grand Nationals was the end of January, with half of the fees needing to be paid. Nationals are November 12 – 14, 2009. He also stated he plans to

participate in a BOA Regional in Ohio during Fall Break where the band can spend the night and go to Kings Island. James Arnold moved to pay the fees and attend BOA Nationals in November, Frankie Reynolds 2nd, motion carried.

DVD's, License Plates, Clings: Kim Bowman had the photo DVD's available to distribute. The license plates and clings were also distributed for those paid.

Barbara Rupard made a motion to adjourn, Vickie Handy 2nd, the meeting adjourned at 6:32 p.m.
