

Bourbon County Band Booster Meeting March 17, 2008

President Tamara Johnson opened the meeting at 6:00 p.m. The Secretary's report was distributed by Sarah Auvenshine. There were no changes or additions; the report was approved by common consent. Old Business:

Band Fee Proposal: We need to make a change in the Band Fee Proposal that was voted on last month. The 2nd sentence of the 3rd paragraph of the Proposal should have read, "Points earned would go towards band instrument repair, and special trips such as Florida, etc." Barbara Rupard made the motion, Kim Crowell 2nd and the motion passed.

Pie Peddler: Pie sales ended last Friday (3-14-08). Tamara and Kelly will be picking up the pies on March 29 and distributing them.

Band Contest for 08: Mr. Hale stated that we would not be holding a band contest in the fall. Mid-States officials pick your judges for you and he is concerned that they might choose judges from California or Florida and we would have to fly them in and pay for their hotels, etc. KMEA contests are plentiful and we would be lucky to get 4 or 5 bands to come to our contest. This may be something we could do in the future.

Mr. Hale states that Marcus has agreed to our offer to work with our guard (marching band and winter guard). He is planning on moving to Paris soon.

Blair had no report regarding the cleaning/waxing of the band trailer.

New Business:

There is a band contest at Western Carolina University, NC at the end of fall break.
