Old Business: Nationals: November 13-15, 2009. We have reserved rooms at the Downtown Hyatt in Indianapolis, IN. They are \$160.00/night. \$160.00 is due by 10-9-09 with the balance due 10-30-09. Tamara has the list of rooms.

Bingo: We lost \$439.38 from 8-18 to 9-17 at Bingo. After discussion, Patty Sledd moved to finish September working Tues and Thurs, in October, we will work Tuesday's only. New Business: Fund raisers: Bev Bales stated that Butter Braids will be ready for sale in Nov/Dec for a December delivery.

We will sell Pies in Nov for Thanksgiving delivery. The price has been lowered to \$12.00 to \$13.00 each.

We can also work for Amazon.com wrapping gifts. We would need at least 3 people to work 4 hour shifts through the day. We earn 60 cents per gift wrapped. Day shifts earn 75 cents a gift. The shifts are: 8am-12pm; 2pm-6pm; 7pm-11pm and 10pm – 2am. Saturday shifts are also available.

Workers must be at least 18 years old and must arrive 15 minutes prior to the beginning of the shift. Beth Monarch moved to work the Amazon.com fund raiser. Pam Rule 2nd, motion carried. We will arrange shifts at the October meeting.

Spirit Cards: We agreed to a 2 year contract with the Spirit Card people. If we do not sell spirit cards this year, we will not be able to sell them ever again. The Spirit card lady said we could take the card and sell what ever we could and return the rest. After discussion Patty Sledd moved to NOT sell Spirit Cards, Marjorie Abney 2nd and the motion carried.

Kings Island will be about \$5300 for rooms and tickets and Great Wolf Lodge will be about \$3200.00 for rooms and tickets. Marjorie Abney moved to stay at the Great Wolf Lodge Saturday night and Sunday. Pam Rule 2nd and the motion carried. Parents will be on their own for rooms.

Lynn Switzer talked Balfour Co into refunding the Bourbon County Board of Education \$2000.00 on the price of the state rings. The board voted to spend that \$2000 on a new tower for Mr. Hale! Thanks to Mrs. Switzer and the Board!!
