

Bourbon County Band Boosters
May 21, 2007

(This meeting was held prior to the spring concert.)

The meeting was opened by President Kelly McIntosh at 6:04 p.m. The Secretary's Report was distributed. No changes or additions were heard. The minutes were approved by common consent. The Treasurer's Report was distributed. No changes or additions were heard. The Treasurer's Report was approved by common consent.

Old Business:

Bingo: The current workers are getting burned out. We must find new people to help or consider working Bingo 1 night each week. An announcement will be made during this evening's concert asking for help. Current workers need to find a replacement when they cannot work. 5:30-8:00 is the best pull-tab selling time. We might consider working shifts, but this would not be necessary if people work their assigned nights. There is also a sheet in the lobby to sign up to help with Bingo and all summer fund-raisers.

Texas Hold 'Em Tournament: Marjorie Abney has spoken with Anderson County. They have held several Texas Hold 'Em Tournaments. They have said that the tournaments are quite profitable. We would have a maximum of 200 patrons. 1,000 chips cost \$119.00. If we had 100 patrons, we would need 100,000 chips. Marjorie got the official rules from Texasholdem.com. We would need 40 volunteers working, with 30 of them dealing cards. Our tentative date is Aug. 18, 2007. The tournament would last approx. 5 hours. Anderson Co. pays a \$7500.00 1st prize. They pay through 8th place with 5th-8th receiving \$700.00 each. We could adjust the payout if we didn't get 200 patrons. We would charge \$100.00 per patron. Kelly McIntosh suggested we get volunteers lined up before we buy the chips and advertise the tournament. Eric Hale suggested we could pay Anderson Co. to help us run it. Discussion was tabled until volunteers were lined up.

Yard Sale: Paula Hyatt stated that we have only received a small amount of items to be sold. The Bo. Co. Homemakers are having a yard sale this weekend and we can have their leftovers. Anyone who can help needs to meet at the Thornberry Storage Buildings at 3:30 on May 26 to help pick up the Homemaker items. Please talk to all of your friends and try to find

more donations for our sale. We will begin setting up the yard sale on Thursday, May 31 about noon. The actual sale will be Friday, June 1 from 8 am to 4 pm and Saturday, June 2 from 8 am to 2 pm. Goodwill will be at the sale at 2 pm to pick up what we don't sell. Paula Hyatt's phone number is 707-7202 if you have something to donate or can help.

New Business:

Team Spirit Cushions: Team Spirit has contacted Kelly McIntosh regarding a fund raiser to sell seat cushions. Team Spirit will contact local businesses and print their ads on a Maroon and Gold cushion. They will give us 300 cushions; all we have to do is sell them for a 100% profit. The company makes its money on the ads; we make our money by selling the cushions. Paula Hyatt made a motion to allow Team Spirit to get the ads and make the cushions, Ann Massie 2nd and the motion passed.

It was brought to our attention that some people do not have internet access and they are in dire need of a newsletter. Kelly McIntosh said she will take care of getting a newsletter to those people.

Festival of the Bluegrass: (at the Horse Park) Albert Elkins is in charge of this event. The Festival of the Bluegrass is held June 7-9, 2007. We need volunteers to come to the Horse Park and show cars where to park or to check arm bands. The shifts are 10-2, 2-6 and 6-11. If you work an early shift you are welcome to stay for the shows.

Trash Pick up: Awilda Mora is in charge of this endeavor. We will be picking up trash this Saturday, May 26th. Meet at the High School. The other days will June 16th and July 21st. This is a great fund raiser and good for the community as well.
