

## Bourbon County Band Booster Meeting June 18, 2007

President Kelly McIntosh opened the meeting at 6:02 p.m. The Secretary's Report was distributed by Sarah Auvenshine. There were no changes or additions and the report was approved by common consent. The Treasurer's Report was distributed by Barbara Rupard. There were no changes or additions and the report was approved by common consent. The check from the Bluegrass Festival will be coming soon.

Old Business: Yard Sale: We cleared \$998.00 with 349 hours worked. Paula did a great job and has agreed to run the yard sale in 2008.

Texas Hold 'em: Marjorie Abney was not available to give us additional details.

Bourbon Co. Fair: We will be working the gate only. We did not have enough workers to work the gate and park cars. The Bo. Co. baseball team will be parking cars. Students are not allowed to work the gate so if our band students want to help, they can help the baseball team parking cars. The gate earns \$2500.00, parking cars earns \$600.00. We still need help on Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday. Please make sure you contact Kelly McIntosh if you want to work the fair.

New Business: Student band fees for 2007-2008 are \$450.00 (\$400.00 for fees and \$50.00 for food). Each student must pay \$150.00 (\$100.00 for fees and \$50.00 for food). They can work off the remaining \$300.00, if desired. If a family has more than one student in the band, the subsequent students will be charged \$250.00 (\$200.00 for fees and \$50.00 for food). The subsequent students must pay \$100.00 (\$50.00 for fees and \$50.00 for food). They can work off the remaining \$150.00, if desired. Motion made by Sarah Auvenshine, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Blair Rule. Motion passed.

Tommi Greatbatch moved that all marchers for 2007-2008 must have the first portion of their band fees (\$150.00) paid by the first day of band camp (July 11), the remainder of the fees are due by the first day of school (Aug 7). Debbie Mitchell 2<sup>nd</sup>. Motion passed.

It was decided that we would set up a payment plan for the 2008-2009 marching season, beginning in January 2008. All new marchers will have \$150.00 due by the first day of band camp with the remainder of the fees due by the first day of school in '08.

Paula Hyatt's father donated a heater to the yard sale this year. She didn't want it to go in the yard sale but be raffled off. We didn't have time to get enough other items to raffle with it by yard sale time. She now has about 20 items to raffle. We will be setting up a booth at the fair to sell raffle tickets. We need 2 adults to work the booth each night of the fair. Paula will be available for most nights, so we need 1 volunteer each night. Please contact Paula Hyatt if you would like to volunteer. Some of the items we have for the raffle include: Big Buddy Heater, Something from Quillin's, oil changes, hanging baskets from Smits and several gift certificates. Paula will use tables and chairs from the band room. She has already secured a canopy.

We need to strip the letters/pictures off of the old band trailer. We need new letters/pictures for the new band trailer. We need to find 4 wheelers for regionals and state. They will no longer be supplying them for us.

Kelly McIntosh is working on the newsletter. It will be mailed as soon as she gets an accurate address list.

Mr. Hale stated that we will be traveling to Florida for the spring trip. We will travel by charter bus. We need to have 56 passengers to fill the bus. We will be going to Universal Studios and Coco beach. The tentative cost is \$424.00 per person.
